

Sample engagement or operationalization prompts

Timespan-specific

- Did you have a specific timespan in mind for this question / analysis?
- How do you determine when these conditions take place?

Subjective terms or statements (e.g. good/bad, better/worse, high/low, "Impact", etc)

- How do you define <term>?
- Could you explain\sketch\show what <term> means in the data?

Data-specific

- How would you determine what data is relevant to address this question?
- How would you collect this data?

Condition-specific

- How would you determine the presence of <condition> in the data?
- What monitors would you use for measuring\determining these conditions?

Task-specific

- Could you give a sample circumstance as an example of this situation?
- What are you looking for (or expecting to see) in the data?

Activity-specific

- What makes <activity> stand out from the rest of the data?

Comparison-specific

- What aspects of the data are important for you to compare <Opt1> to <opt2>?

Specificity

1. Clarification: What do you mean by this?
 - a. Relevance: How to determine which data is relevant to address this question?
 - i. Collection: How would you collect this data?

Criteria for selecting alternative question

Stop participants when their question requires access to 3rd party datasets which we don't have. Let them know what data we do have access to and ask them to pose a different question.
